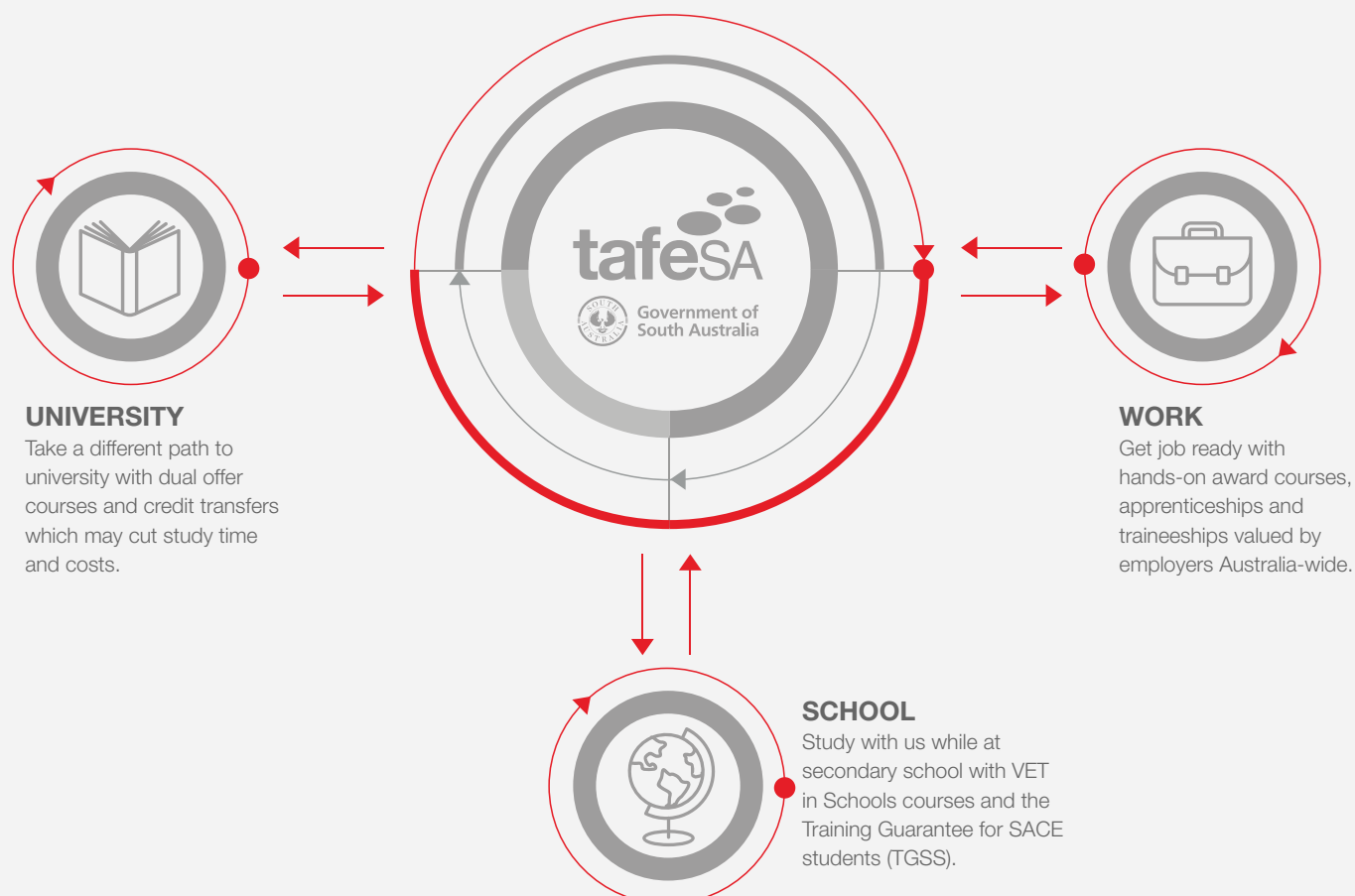

A TAFE SA/Flinders University Dual Award Partnership Degree allows students to gain both a TAFE SA and a university qualification within the one degree. Students benefit from the strengths of TAFE SA and university learning, combining applied and theoretical knowledge with practical skills.

## DUAL OFFER COURSES

TAFE SA offers more than 50 dual offer courses in partnership with the South Australian public universities. With dual offer courses, you are accepted into both a TAFE SA qualification and a connected university program. This means that once you complete your TAFE SA course successfully, you have guaranteed entry – with credit – into university.

Studying a dual offer course is a great way to set yourself apart from other graduates. You will benefit from TAFE SA's vocational experience and insights, as well as graduating with two qualifications instead of one.

## CREDIT TRANSFER

Study you've completed previously can be recognised when you begin further study at TAFE SA or university. This means you don't have to repeat coursework, saving you time and money.

Prior qualifications will be recognised for some time after graduation so a gap is generally no problem when applying for a credit transfer. TAFE SA works closely with universities to create clear credit pathways. This helps you to plan your future studies easily.

## UNIVERSITY ENTRY

Once you have successfully completed a TAFE SA qualification at Certificate IV level or higher, you can use this to apply for entry into most university programs. Sometimes universities guarantee admission based on your TAFE SA qualification.

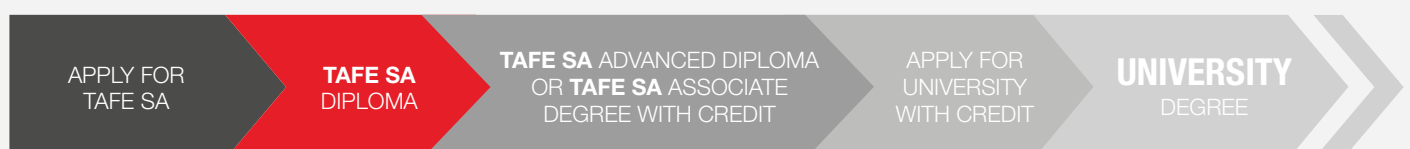
## FROM UNIVERSITY TO TAFE SA

# FOUND YOUR COURSE? HERE'S WHAT'S NEXT

Found your perfect course? Now it's time to find it online in the Courses section of the TAFE SA website. Click the green Apply Now button, complete your details and submit your application.

Applying is free so if more than one course has caught your eye, why not apply?

Information on intake, entry requirements, recognition of prior learning, costs and assistance options is available online for each course.

## ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

You may need to meet certain selection criteria or course admission requirements to be accepted into a course. These may include:

- > the Australian Core Skills Profile for Adults (CSPA) test which ensures satisfactory reading, writing and numeracy skills
- > portfolio submission
- > written assessments
- > auditions.

Check each course for details. There are many courses that do not have admission requirements.

Where there are more applicants than places available, applications are ranked by selection processes which can include prior educational results and core skills assessment.

The number of places available vary across TAFE SA locations.

## INTAKES

Courses can have either:

- > Two intakes a year - Semester 1 for a February start and Semester 2 for a July start, or
- > Continuous intakes where offers are made throughout the year, allowing you to start in Term 1, 2, 3 or 4.

## STUDY COSTS

The cost of a course depends on the number of hours of training, the type of study involved and specialist materials required. Vocational Education and Training courses that can potentially meet the state's workforce needs are supported through WorkReady by the South Australian Government to reduce study costs (eligibility and subsidy criteria apply).

## SUBSIDISED TRAINING

You may be eligible for a government subsidised training place. For more information visit [skills.sa.gov.au](http://skills.sa.gov.au) or call 1800 506 266.

## FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

VET Student Loans or FEE-HELP are available for selected qualifications. These have eligibility requirements, including demonstration of satisfactory reading, writing and numeracy skills by sitting the CSPA. You may also be eligible for a fee concession, payment by instalments or a fee reduction or exemption. Talk to TAFE SA on 1800 882 661 (freecall) about your options.

## RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING

Your previous study or work experience can be recognised when you begin further study at TAFE SA. You can apply to have your previous study assessed to see where it is equivalent in content and learning outcomes to your planned study.

## CREDIT TRANSFER FOR PREVIOUSLY COMPLETED STUDIES

Credit transfer allows you to receive credit for previously completed unit(s) of competency. It is important to apply for your recognition for credit transfer at enrolment or as close to enrolment as possible, to confirm your final fee.
