


TAFE SA offers more than 70 dual offer courses in partnership with South Australian public universities.

## TAFE SA TO UNI CREDIT TRANSFER

Credit transfer recognises the parts of a TAFE SA qualification that are equivalent in content and level to parts of some university programs.

To claim credit, you must formally apply to the university in accordance with their processes and you may need to show evidence of your previous studies, such as a qualification parchment.

Being eligible for credit does not guarantee that you will be offered a place in the university program.

Credit will normally only be granted after you have been offered a place.





## WHY CHOOSE VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING (VET)?

- > The VET sector currently provides training courses for nine out of ten occupations predicted to have the greatest growth of new jobs over the next five years. (Commonwealth Government Department of Employment).
- > VET students can take as little as six months to requalify and reskill.
- > More than 78% of VET graduates are employed after training.
- > VET graduates earn wages comparable to, if not exceeding, that of university graduates.
- > 82% of graduates who participated in VET as part of an apprenticeship or traineeship are employed after training.
- > With workers averaging just six years and eight months per role, TAFE SA makes it easy to retrain, upskill, change careers or shift from employment to self-employment and back again.



In a rapidly changing employment environment, the speed, value and skills that VET provides are the solution to today's growing needs.
